Personal-use aerosols e.g. hair spray, deodorant, etc. <i>Individual cans not above 500mL or 500g, total per passenger not above 2L or 2kg Cap must be fitted to prevent accidental release</i>	✓	✗	✗
Camping gas cylinders, oil sprays, insect killers, etc.	✗	✗	✗
Lithium Batteries and Devices Containing Lithium Batteries			
E-Cigarettes/vapes <i>Must be individually protected to prevent accidental activation The use of e-cigarettes is strictly prohibited while on board the aircraft</i>	✗	✓	✓
Portable electronic devices containing lithium batteries <i>Rechargeable lithium-ion battery, capacity not above 100Wh, or Non-rechargeable lithium-metal battery, lithium content not greater than 2g</i>	✓ <i>Not Recommended</i>	✓	✓
Spare or loose lithium-ion batteries <i>Capacity not above 100Wh Each battery must be individually protected to prevent short-circuits</i>	✗	✓	✓
Spare or loose lithium-ion batteries <i>Capacity greater than 100Wh</i>	✗	✗	✗
Spare or loose lithium metal batteries <i>Lithium content not greater than 2g – AA size or smaller Each battery must be individually protected to prevent short-circuits</i>	✗	✓	✓
Spare or loose lithium metal batteries <i>Lithium content greater than 2g – C size or larger</i>	✗	✗	✗
Restricted Equipment			
Ammunition <i>Maximum 5kg, securely packaged in accordance with UN 0012 or UN 0014 Ammunition must be declared, and valid firearms licence must be presented</i>	✓	✗	✗
Firearms <i>Must be in a locked bag, unloaded, with the bolt or magazine removed if possible Firearms must be declared, and valid firearms licence must be presented</i>	✓	✗	✗
Knives, sharp objects, bats, etc. <i>Or any other item which could be used as a weapon</i>	✓	✗	✗
Tasers, pepper spray, etc.	✗	✗	✗
